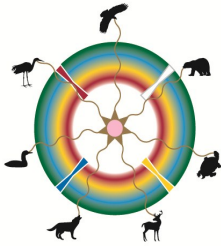

Eyaa-Keen Healing Centre Inc. focuses on providing a unique form of Aboriginal Traditional based trauma treatment and psychological rehabilitation. The process is for people to start living fully alive, thriving, and making good decisions in their own lives.

Eyaa-Keen's programs and services are designed to improve the well-being of all Aboriginal people by addressing issues and strengthening the goals in their life through a series of Aboriginal Traditional based sessions. Individual/Group sessions address the needs of those affected by trauma and loss including Family Violence, Victims of Crime and the Legacy of Indian Residential Schools.

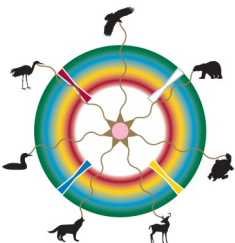
- * Spring five day session to be held in April.
