## RESOLUTION HEALTH SUPPORT WORKER (RHSW) - Term/Full Time

Eyaa-Keen Healing Centre Inc. is seeking a reliable, mature and independent individual to provide emotional support to IRS Former Students, their family members and support people. The successful candidate will be of Aboriginal descent with a demonstrated interest and commitment to working in the healing and wellness field.

RHSW responsibilities include conducting intake, and providing information on resources available. The position will also include providing emotional support to former students at Hearings, TRC gatherings, form fillings, prehearing preparation, follow-up, as requested. As well, RHSW will provide support at various healing training sessions we hold and also at ceremonies. There will be general administrative duties and some outreach work within the community to share information about programs.

Reporting to the Co-Directors, the successful candidate must:

- Be a self starter and able to work independently
- Must know how to use a computer ie: Word, email
- Able to gather statistics on a daily basis
- Able to make reports as needed both written and verbal
- Have assessment skills
- Need to be free to travel as needed
- Be substance free
- Must be willing to participate in mandatory in-house self development training
- Have a strong awareness of the culture of Aboriginal people
- Be willing to participate in ceremonies and group sessions to provide support
- Understanding of the Ojibwa or Cree language an asset
- Have the ability to be calm in a busy environment
- Be willing to learn and open to new challenges
